Please note: Badminton Scotland advise that candidates from UKCC Level 1 attend Level 1+ before completing UKCC Level 2. There is a considerable increase in technical and coaching requirements from UKCC Level 1 to UKCC Level 2, which is why Badminton Scotland developed Level 1+. Candidates are required to sign that they understand it is their responsibility if they choose to jump straight to UKCC Level 2 without first completing Level 1+.

4. Your name may be offered to local authorities for employment on a coaching basis only if you tick the data protection box.

6. Reduced price ticket for National Coaching Conference
7. Affiliation to BADMINTONScotland.
