In order to ensure consistency across the various competitions throughout the year, each ranking competition is allocated a specific grade. The criteria for each type of grading tournament is shown below.

If your tournament is a ranking event, please indicate on your application which grade of ranking tournament you are applying for – Grade A, B or C. The Events Committee will consider all requests and advise the Tournament Organiser of the grade of tournament awarded for season 2023/24.

Following completion of the tournament an abbreviated referee's report requires to be completed and returned by the Referee of all graded events to ensure the event has complied with the criteria for the grading of the competition.

Please note, re-draws should only be done in exceptional circumstances. We have received a number of queries from unhappy competitors regarding re-draws in recent years, so if you are organising a ranking tournament, please do not do a re-draw of any event without first contacting either myself or Morag McCulloch for advice.

Additionally, following feedback from players and tournament organisers we now require the closing date for entries for all ranking dates to be at least 2 weeks before the start of the competition and for start times and final information to be sent to competitors at least 3 days before the start of the event.

Finally, going forwards it will be a requirement that only players who are affiliated to Badminton Scotland will be able to enter sanctioned Badminton Scotland events. From the start of season 2023/24 we aim to have updated our Tournament Software account to link in with our JustGo membership system, so that this can be monitored and controlled automatically.

Badminton Scotland's age group qualification in season 2023/24 will continue to be in line with Badminton Europe,
