# 2024 Midland Doubles B Championships (Senior)

## Tournament Conditions

1. The Tournament will be conducted according to the tournament regulations of BADMINTONScotland, including the prohibition of doping for which tests may be carried out.
2. Players must hold an active membership with BadmintonScotland in order to enter.
3. A separate entry must be submitted by each competitor. No pair shall be accepted for a doubles event unless entries have been received from both players. Players indicating "partner required" will be paired wherever possible. Where there is no available partner, entry fee refunds will be given.

5. Entries sent without the appropriate entry fees will not be accepted. Late entries may only be accepted at discretion of Tournament Organiser. Unfortunately refunds cannot be issued for withdrawals after the entry closing date.
6. The tournament committee reserve the right, if necessary, to:
  - Refuse to accept an entry without giving their reasons for doing so
  - Limit the number of entries in events (max 32)
7. Any unannounced withdrawals will be notified to BADMINTONScotland and monitored by the Events Committee.
8. Matches will be best of 3 games to 21 points with setting. The Referee reserves the right to amend the scoring format in any event if necessary due to time constraints.
9. Play will be continuous from 9:00am on Sat 21<sup>st</sup> Sept commencing with MD and WD events. XD event will start early afternoon following completion of level doubles events. Play is estimated to finish 6pm-8pm
10. An email will be sent to all competitors 2-3 days prior to the event confirming 1<sup>st</sup> tie timings.
11. Players should expect a minimum of 3 matches per event. Depending on entry numbers, qualifying pools format may be used.
12. No Coaching permitted. Intervals of 60s during each game when leading score reaches 11 points, and 120s between games shall be allowed in all matches.
13. Players shall report/check-in at the Organisers Table on arrival. Players should be in attendance and ready to play at least 15mins prior to first scheduled match. Players absent when called on to play may be scratched.
14. The Organisers reserve the right to add to or alter these conditions. Their decision in all matters will be final.
