2025 VICTOR Midland Junior Championships (U15/U19) Tournament Conditions

- The Tournament will be conducted according to the tournament regulations of BADMINTONscotland, including the prohibition of doping for which tests may be carried out.
- The Tournament Age Group events shall be restricted to players who were born as follows:

U15 - Born in 2011 or later

U19 – Born in 2007 or later

Player's first right of entry is to their own age group. They may however enter an older age group subject to the right of refusal from the Tournament Committee.

3. A separate entry form must be used by each competitor and each competitor may play in a maximum of 3 events – singles, doubles and mixed. Players are not permitted to enter across 2 different age groups without prior approval from Organiser.

No pair shall be accepted for a doubles event unless entry forms have been received from both players.

Players indicating "partner required" will be paired wherever possible. Where there is no available partner, entry fee refunds will be given.

- 5. Entries sent without the appropriate entry fees will not be accepted.

 Late entries may only be accepted at discretion of Tournament Organiser.

 Unfortunately refunds cannot be issued for withdrawals after the entry closing date.
- 6. The tournament committee reserve the right, if necessary, to:
 - Refuse to accept an entry without giving their reasons for doing so
 - Limit the number of entries in events
- 7. Any unannounced withdrawals will be notified to BadmintonScotland and monitored by the Events Committee.
- 8. Players will be guaranteed a minimum of 2 matches per event.

 Events may be played in qualifying pools of size 3 or 4 (or round robin pool if small Entry).

 In this case there will be no consolation events, however if time permits, we may arrange

an extra "consolation" tie for players who don't qualify from Pools.

NOTE: The Tournament Committee reserves the right to move a player/pair to a different pool right up to start of play if a withdrawal leaves pool numbers imbalanced.

Example: If a withdrawal leaves one Pool of 2, and other Pools of 4, then a player drawn in Position 4 of a Pool of 4 will be moved to the Pool with only 2 players.

- Matches will be best of 3 games to 21 points with setting.(Referee has discretion to change scoring format in event of unforeseen circumstances)
- Coaching will be permitted at Intervals only for U19 age group only (as per BadmintonScotland guidelines). Coaches must be on BadmintonScotland's Coaching Register.
- 11. Players shall report to the Committee Table on arrival each day and must subsequently report to the hall table when called.
 Players should be in attendance and ready to play at least 15mins prior to first scheduled match. Players absent when called on to play may be scratched.
- 12. Play will be continuous from 8:45am on Sat 15th Feb commencing with Singles events. Saturday main draw events will be played up to and including Quarter-Finals. Mixed Doubles will take place on Sun 16th Feb commencing at 9:00am, followed by all Main Draw events Semi-Finals. Finals should commence around 12noon on Sun 16th Feb. Prizegiving ceremony will take place after the last Final is completed on Sun 16th Feb. Please note that scheduling is subject to change depending on size of entry.
- 13. Submission of entry form includes Players granting permission to be included in any official photographs that may be taken by tournament organisers. If any Players do NOT grant their permission they must inform the Referee on arrival.
- 14. Clothing and advertising must conform to the Badminton World Federation (BWF) Regulations.
