Dear Tournament Organiser

We are now creating the tournament programme for season 2025/26 so I would be grateful if you can let us know the proposed dates for your tournament(s) by completing the questionnaire at the following link: https://forms.office.com/e/0afjRPtWuC (a separate submission for each tournament). Please do so by Monday 21 April, in order to allow us to put the draft calendar of events forward for approval at Badminton Scotland's AGM.

If your tournament is a ranking event, please indicate on your application which level of ranking tournament you are applying for. Please also note that from season 25/26 onwards we are renaming our ranking events to be Gold, Silver & Bronze (replacing Grade A, B & C respectively) and adding a new level - Copper. The Events Committee will consider all requests and advise the Tournament Organiser of the level of tournament awarded.

The criteria for each level of tournament is shown below. Please remember that Bronze events now need to be seeded. Tournament organisers are responsible for creating the seedings for their Bronze events and the seeds should be based on the Scottish ranking lists. Tournament organisers are granted the flexibility to apply their judgement in cases where there is a clear anomaly. Tournament organisers can contact Badminton Scotland's Head of Events for further information and/or support with this if required.

Tournament organisers should continue to contact Badminton Scotland's appointed person for seeds for Gold and Silver events.

Following completion of the tournament an abbreviated referee's report requires to be completed and returned by the Referee to ensure the event has complied with the criteria for the level of competition.

Please note that any tournament which is included in our calendar must divide prizes equally between male and female events. This will ensure that prizes are distributed in a way that is equitable and fair to all competitors.

Note - Scottish National Championships will receive a National Grade higher than "Gold".

Please note, re-draws should only be done in exceptional circumstances. If you are organising a ranking tournament, please do not re-draw any event without first contacting either myself or Morag McCulloch for advice.

Please also remember that the closing date for entries for all ranking dates should be at least 2 weeks before the start of the competition. Start times should be sent to competitors at least 3 days before the start of the event.

Finally, if you are running your event in groups, on Tournament Software please ensure you change the settings in Tournament Properties / Round Robin to "BWF" to ensure the final group placings are correct.

Badminton Scotland's age group qualification in season 2025/26 will continue to be in line with Badminton Europe:
