- 1. The Tournament will be conducted under the rules of the Badminton World Federation (BWF). A player shall be qualified to enter a Scottish National Championships providing the player satisfies all of the following regulations:
- (a) is in good standing with Badminton Scotland
- To "be in good standing" includes being a member of Badminton Scotland
- 2. All matches will be best of three games to 21. An interval not exceeding 60 seconds will be allowed in every game after one player/pair has reached 11 points. An interval of 2 minutes will be allowed between the first and second and between the second and third games, but a player may not leave the court.
- 3. All matches will be played in accordance with the BWF Laws of Badminton. Details of these Laws can be found on the BWF website www.bwfbadminton.org. Players will not receive advice from a coach at any time during a match.
- 4. Players absent when called on to play will be scratched.
- 5. A separate entry must be submitted by each player.
- 6. No pair shall be accepted for a doubles event unless entry forms have been received by both players. Players indicating "Partner Required" will be paired where possible.
- 7. The Committee reserves the right to refuse entry without giving their reasons.
- 8. No entry will be accepted from any player who has taken part in any unauthorised Tournament, League or Match.
- 9. Feather shuttlecocks shall be used (brand to be confirmed).
- 10. Entries must be received by Badminton Scotland, accompanied by the appropriate entry fees, NOT LATER THAN WEDNESDAY 5 NOVEMBER 2025.
- 11. Players must hold themselves ready to play not later than 9.00 am on Saturday 29th November 2025 and 9.30 am on Sunday 30th November 2025. Players must be able to play all weekend. Previous scheduling is not necessarily an indication of this year's scheduling.
- 12. A player may enter a maximum of three events. Players may play in more than one age group, but may not play the same discipline in more than one age group.

- 13. Players must have reached the required age for the categories entered by 31 December 2025.
- 14. The committee reserves the right to play any or all events in pool or round robin formats.
- 15. Badminton Scotland is opposed to the use of drugs in sport and is a member of and subject to the antidoping jurisdiction of the BWF and UKAD. The tournament will be conducted with accordance to the tournament regulation of Badminton Scotland, including the anti-doping rules and tests may be carried out. The anti-doping rules of Badminton Scotland are binding on all athletes, Athlete Support Personnel and other persons participating in this event/tournament. A copy of the anti-doping rules can be found at www.ukad.org.uk/about/anti-doping-rules and further information can be found at https://www.Badminton Scotland.org.uk/anti-doping/. Remember that many common asthma medications, and medications used for other common medical conditions require the player to apply for a Therapeutic Exemption Certificate from UK Sport.
- 16. Late entries and entries sent without the appropriate entry fees are unlikely to be accepted. Late entries may only be accepted at the discretion of the tournament director. A financial penalty is imposed by Badminton Scotland of £5 per event for late entries to these Championships.
- 17. Regarding unannounced withdrawals from tournaments, a warning letter will be sent on the first offence and on a subsequent offence the matter will be referred to the Disciplinary Committee.
- 18. No refunds will be considered if withdrawal is notified after the draw has been made.
- 19. Depending on the size of the entry events in certain age groups may be combined, meaning that players/pairs may be asked to play in younger age groups.

Anti-Doping

Badminton Scotland is opposed to the use of drugs in sport and is a member of and subject to the anti-doping jurisdiction of the BWF and UKAD. The tournament will be conducted with accordance to the tournament regulation of Badminton Scotland, including the anti-doping rules and tests may be carried out. The anti-doping rules of Badminton Scotland are binding on all athletes, Athlete Support Personnel and other persons participating in this event/tournament.
