The referee shall have the power to check the player's age at any time. All players of clubs affiliated to their National Associations to BWF.

If an event in any age group has less than four players or pairs entered, the organiser may cancel that event and merge the entered players with an event of a younger age group.

	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. No player shall be eligible to compete unless he or she is a player in good standing with his or her national association. To “be in good standing” includes being a member of BADMINTONScotland (for Scottish players) 2. All matches shall be the best of three games to 21. An interval not exceeding sixty seconds shall be permitted when a player/pair reaches eleven points in any game. An interval not exceeding two minutes shall be allowed between games. 3. The period for knocking up before any match shall not exceed two minutes. 4. All matches will be played in accordance with the BWF Laws of Badminton, which can be found at www.bwfbadminton.org. Coaching breaks will be allowed in line with the regulations published on Badminton Scotland’s website at https://badmintonscotland.org.uk/wp-content/uploads/2025/09/Coaching-Breaks-September-2025.pdf 5. The Committee may restrict entries into all events. 6. Entry Forms: If players are unable to enter online, Entries must be sent to emma@badmintonscotland.org.uk ,accompanied by the appropriate remittance for entry fees, NOT LATER THAN, Friday 19th DECEMBER 2025. 7. Late entries and entries sent without the appropriate entry fees will not be accepted. 8. No pair shall be accepted for a doubles event unless entry forms have been received from both players. 9. The Committee reserves the right to refuse entry without giving their reasons. 10. The Committee reserves the right to play any or all events in pool or round robin formats and to add to or alter these Conditions and its decisions are final. 11. Late entries and entries sent without the appropriate entry fees are unlikely to be accepted. Late entries may only be accepted at the discretion of the tournament director. A financial penalty is imposed by BADMINTONScotland of £5 per event for late entries to these Championships. 12. Regarding unannounced withdrawals from tournaments, a warning letter will be sent on the first offence and on a subsequent offence the matter will be referred to the Disciplinary Committee. 13. Photographs and footage recorded during the event and information provided on this form may be used for promotional purposes. Players must advise the Referee on arrival at the Championships if they do not wish to be included in photographs or film footage which may be taken over the course of the Championships.
Anti-Doping	<p>Badminton Scotland is opposed to the use of drugs in sport and is a member of and subject to the anti-doping jurisdiction of the BWF and UKAD. The tournament will be conducted with accordance to the tournament regulation of Badminton Scotland, including the anti-doping rules and tests may be carried out. The anti-doping rules of Badminton Scotland are binding on all athletes, Athlete Support Personnel and other persons participating in this event/tournament.
